

CYCLOPS BATTERY CHARGING INSTRUCTIONS

Battery Charging: All Cyclops Adventuresports battery powered lights come with a smart charger. The light on the Smart Charger will turn green once charging is complete. Never use any other charger, other than the supplied Cyclops Adventuresports Li-Poly charger. Never charge your Li-Poly battery near heat or fire.

Note: Use your common sense when riding at night. It is wise to ride in areas that you are familiar with. Do not drink and ride, be safe and have a great time!

WARNING - PLEASE READ

Li-Poly Batteries: Cyclops goes the extra mile, to provide Industry leading battery technology. Li-Poly batteries are the lightest, most powerful batteries available.

These batteries must be cared for properly. Improper use can result in serious injury, fire or death.

Caution:

- Do not place the battery in fire or apply heat to the battery.
- Do not pierce the battery with nails, strike the battery with a hammer, step on the battery, or otherwise damage the outer casing.
- Do not subject the battery pack to strong impacts or shocks.
- Do not expose the battery to water or salt water, or allow the battery to get wet.
- Do not disassemble or modify the battery. The battery contains safety and protection devices which, if damaged, may cause the battery to generate heat, rupture or ignite.
- Do not place the battery on or near fires, stoves, or other high temperature locations.
- Do not leave the battery in direct sunlight, or use or store the battery inside cars in hot weather. Doing so may cause the battery to generate heat, rupture, or ignite. Using the battery in this manner may also result in a loss of performance and a shortened life expectancy.

- **Never short circuit, reverse polarity, disassemble, damage or heat the battery pack over 100°C (212°F). If an exposed lithium battery does start on fire, it will burn even more violently if it comes into contact with water or even the moisture in air.**

- **DO NOT THROW WATER ON A BURNING LI-ION BATTERY! A fire extinguisher must be used.**

Getting The Most From Your Cyclops Battery Stack Packs:

Charge your batteries individually, when connecting the batteries, always have both batteries at full charge. **Note:** Plugging a fully charged battery, into a discharged battery may cause damage to the batteries.

- Do not allow batteries to bounce around together in your pack. Tape or zip tie packs together, before placing them in your pack. And never carry tools or other objects in the same pack or pouch as your batteries.
- Store batteries at about 50% capacity and at a low temp. 40 degrees is ideal. Do not freeze batteries.
- Never discharge batteries fully.
- Taking proper care of your Cyclops battery stack packs will bring you years of service.

Warranty:

Cyclops Adventuresports warrants Cyclops battery stack packs to be free from material defects and workmanship, under normal use, if properly installed for a period of 30 days from the date of purchase. If found to be defective, the battery will be repaired or replaced.

This shall constitute the sole remedy to the purchaser and the sole liability of Cyclops Adventuresports to the extent permitting by law.
